It may appear quiet on the Ipswich Central redevelopment site with Hutchinson's Builders officially completing the current phase of demolition and site clearing, however there's plenty going on behind the scenes to ensure the Ipswich CBD's biggest redevelopment in 30 years is on track.

Murphy's Pub: Tenders are now closed for companies applying to take on the Heritage pub's sub-structure works to ensure that underground soil and site erosion. The announcement of the successful bid is set to be announced within days. This will mean that the next tranche of workers will be onsite to carry out the next step of the redevelopment.

Mall upgrade: Tenders will also close this week for companies wishing to be engaged for the upgrade of the existing Mall to return the pedestrian area back into a one-way road.

Design: Design of the Civic Space, Library and Council administration buildings are now well-advanced with Ipswich City Properties preparing to call for tenders. The design phase of the facades of the existing Ipswich Mall buildings has now commenced, with architects working to repurpose some of the existing façade elements while also incorporating new components to create a modern, on-trend city centre.

Car parking: Level 1 of the Ipswich Central car park will remain closed to vehicle parking; however, it will remain open for pedestrians wishing to access the Bradfield Bridge. It is anticipated that this will be a pedestrian only zone until the completion of the upcoming Mall upgrade works.
